Attorney Adkinson explained that the Capacity Fee Workshop is part of the requirements for the Ordinance process to set the city Capacity Fees. The Capacity Fee Study adopted by the Council in February of 2018 will be put on the website for public information.

City Attorney Adkinson will provide a formal Notice of Intent to Act with the recommended fees at the second Council Meeting in July. This process will only address connection fees. Monthly charges for water and sewer service are not part of this Ordinance.
