

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ENACT ORDINANCE

Notice is hereby given that the City Council of the City of Freeport, Florida, shall consider for adoption at the meeting scheduled for August 11, 2020, at 9:00 a.m. at the City Hall in Freeport, Florida,

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 2019-11, THEREBY AMENDING CHAPTER 2 “ADMINISTRATION”, ARTICLE III “OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES”, DIVISION 1 “CITY MANAGER”, SECTION 2-43 “RESIDENCE” TO AMEND THE REQUIREMENTS OF THAT SECTION; AMENDING CHAPTER 2 “ADMINISTRATION”, ARTICLE III “OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES”, DIVISION 1 “CITY MANAGER”, SECTION 2-44 “QUALIFICATIONS” TO CORRECT A SCRIVENERS ERROR IN THE FORMATTING OF SUBSECTIONS 1 AND 2, AND TO CREATE A NEW SECTION 2-44 SUBSECTION 5 PROVIDING FOR THE WAIVER OF QUALIFICATIONS IN TEMPORARY HIRING SCENARIOS; AMENDING CHAPTER 2 “ADMINISTRATION”, ARTICLE III “OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES”, DIVISION 1 “CITY MANAGER”, SECTION 2-45 “DUTIES”, TO DELETE A REFERENCE IN SUBSECTION G TO A NONEXISTING DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT AND SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A copy of the proposed Ordinance is available at City Hall for inspection and all interested persons may appear at the meeting and be heard with respect to the proposed ordinance.

Note: If a person decides to appeal any decision made by the Council with respect to any matter considered at such meeting or hearing, such person will need a record of the proceeding and that, for such purpose, such person may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend the “City Manager” section in the Municipal Code in the City of Freeport, Florida
