



## INVITATION TO JOIN

The City of Freeport would like to offer businesses qualified in the installation of grinder station packages the opportunity to be included in a company directory. This directory will be solely comprised of businesses that can provide the above-mentioned service. This directory shall be supplied to customers that require the installation of a grinder station package in order to connect to the City's sanitary sewer system. If you wish to be considered for inclusion please submit your company's contact information, along with a copy of licensing or other qualifying credentials to the City of Freeport's official email address [freeport@freeportflorida.gov](mailto:freeport@freeportflorida.gov) as soon as possible. If your company meets the qualification criteria you will be notified and added to the directory within 5 business days.

Eligibility requirements are as follows:

- Must be qualified to install all aspects of a grinder station package
- Must follow pump manufacturer's installation instructions to ensure warranty is valid and must provide customer with a copy of the warranty certificate
- Must perform and fill out a pump start-up report if required by manufacturer, providing customer with a copy of the report
- Must meet the City's required pump and electrical specifications (specifications may be picked up from the City's billing department, located at 112 HWY 20 West)
- Must submit pump specifications to: [rfawcett@freeportflorida.gov](mailto:rfawcett@freeportflorida.gov) for review and approval prior to installation
- Must agree to notify the City's billing department upon successful completion of grinder station installation

The City reserves the right to refuse to list any person or company, and to remove any person or company, from this directory if the City determines that such refusal or removal is in the best interests of the public.
